### OPERATION:

#### Turn on:

From the off position, slide the switch forward as far as it will go towards the lens. You should hear two clicks. The light will turn on and stay on.

#### Signal mode:

From the off position, slide the switch forward to the intermittent position. You will here one "click." Press the button above the switch to activate the light. The light will stay on only while the button is depressed.

### BATTERY REPLACEMENT:

The flashlight will operate for approximately 3.5 hours with a new set (2) of batteries. The flashlight will experience a rapid decline in light output for the last 30 minutes. Use only CR123A Lithium batteries (non-rechargeable).

#### Removal:

To replace the batteries, unscrew the yellow lens ring to access the battery cartridge. Slide the cartridge out of the body. To remove the batteries, simply press down on the top-edge of the battery and slide the battery out of the cartridge. Repeat for the second battery. Do not discard the cartridge.

#### Installation:

Always utilize new CR123A batteries in pairs. Do not mix old with new batteries. Do not mix brands. Set the base of the battery (negative) on the bottom spring of the cartridge, push down and slide the top of the battery into place. It will "click" into position. Repeat for second battery.

### MAINTENANCE:

Your light has been designed to be stored for those emergency situations. It has a 10-year shelf life. For the frequent user, make sure all threads and O-ring are clean and free of debris. Periodically lubricate the O-ring with a silicone-based grease, especially if used in a wet environment.

### BULB REPLACEMENT:

1. Unscrew the yellow ring to expose the lamp assembly.
2. Unscrew the shock absorber tube that encases the bulb retaining ring.
3. Remove the bulb and replace with a new bulb.
4. Reinstall the bulb retainer by tightening to a snug fit.
5. Reattach the lens ring to the body. Make sure the bulb end contacts the spring at the tip of the battery cartridge.
6. Tighten the lens ring assembly to the body to a snug fit.

- Brightness: Over 3,000 foot-candles for 2 hours; 400 ft-cd after 4 hours

- Safety pin attached
- Waterproof
